MEDICARE B & IRMAA REIMBURSEMENT



NYSUT retirees are eligible for reimbursement of their Medicare Part B premiums after reaching age 65. This includes the standard premium amount. Retirees should be aware that if they pay more than the standard

amount due to the Income Related Monthly Adjustment Amount (IRMAA), they can also seek reimbursement for these additional costs. **If you are turning or over 65**, please reach out to the Human Resources Department in the district you retired from to inquire about the procedure and timeline for reimbursement.
